- 7% of students have mild/moderate delays, disabilities, or learning needs
- 5% of our students self-identify as Inuit, First Nation or Metis.
- 10% of our students are learning English as an additional language
- **6% of students** require and utilize a variety of services including, support from a Learning Assistant, Speech support, Occupational Therapy or Physical therapy supports, Learning Specialist and School Psychologist consultation, and/or Family School Liaison support at home.
