Together, Edwards students, staff, and families raised over \$1729.45 in gift cards to help support 34 Airdrie families!












Christy Jordan-Fenton is Margaret-Olemaun Pokiak-Fenton's daughter-in-law an Inuvialuit knowledge keeper and residential school survivor. Together they co-authored several books, including Fatty Legs: A True Story, When I Was Eight and Not My Girl. The books recount the life of Margaret-Olemaun Pokiak-Fenton who passed away on June 2, 2021.









